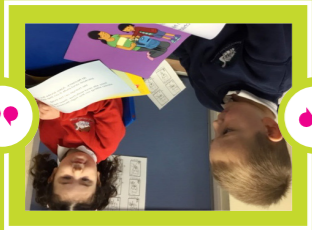

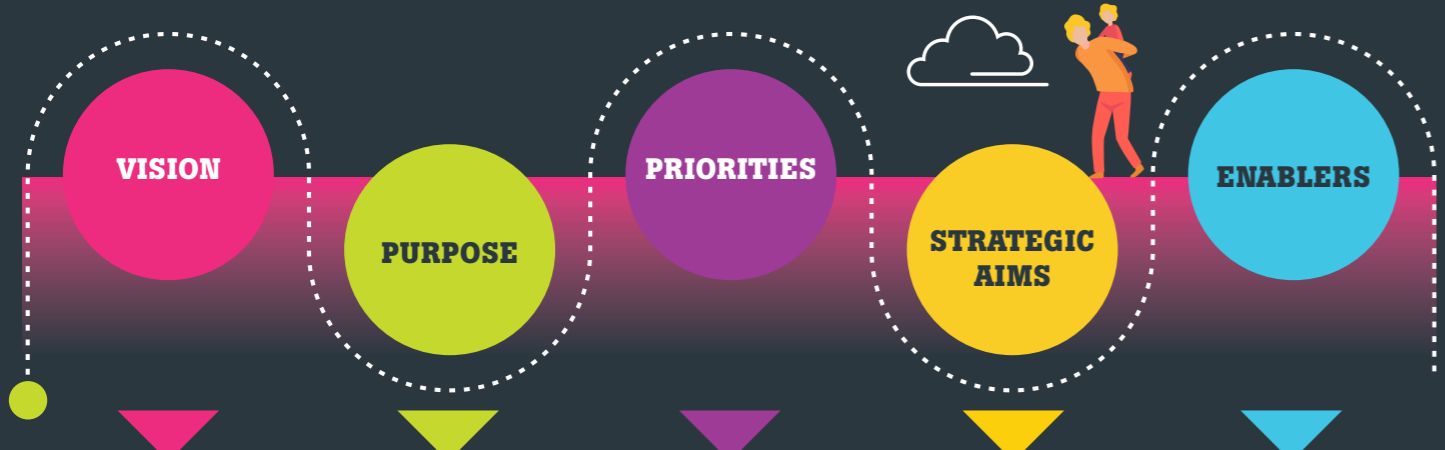

PRIORITIES
Highlighting options of support.

- 4 YEAR ACTIVITIES**
- Map current provision and support.
 - Identify gaps.
 - Invest and implement packages of support to meet need.
 - Grow existing packages of support that work.
 - Develop a communication strategy and a timeline for a public health campaign.
 - Develop a directory of support.
 - Work with key stakeholders to increase capacity and capability within organisations.

SUCCESS FACTORS
A better awareness of what is available.

Working together.

- The Help Kids Talk coordinator will provide support to organisations to prioritise the initiative.
- Create and maintain a shared vision.
- Involve parents/carers in the design of the project and any decisions to be made.
- Establish commitment from key stakeholders.
- Develop support materials and resources to build capability.
- Share and apply co-creation models to support children, young people and families in the design of support options.

Everyone recognises HKT as their responsibility.

Learning for all.

- Map current training available.
- Develop training plan that compliments current provision.
- Develop a system to promote training to all key stakeholders.
- Identify learning needs of key stakeholders and respond effectively.
- Develop training packages where appropriate to meet need.
- Support key stakeholders to include training as part of induction of new staff.
- Provide opportunities for everyone involved to share their learning.
- Share progress reports with commissioning bodies to influence policy & priorities.

A model of delivery that is inclusive and responsive.

Improving the quality of our services.

- Deliver a consistent and co-ordinated approach.
- Develop an evaluation framework (EF).
- Report quarterly on the progress of the project linked to the EF.
- Secure and apply evidence of effectiveness.
- Identify and partner with key strategic improvement experts to support quality provision.
- Provide opportunities for key stakeholders to feedback their experience to inform future design/delivery.
